

Thank you for considering Windsock for storing your RV this winter season! To reserve your space for this fall, please fill out the information sheet, sign the waiver and return with a \$150 non-refundable deposit.

IMPORTANT: On the application and contract sheet, select the date you want to remove your RV in the spring; the date you choose to exit will determine your drop-off date in the fall.

The principle is:

- The first to arrive in the fall is the last to depart in the spring.
- The last to arrive in the fall is the first to depart in the spring.

This allows us to pack the building in the fall, and then unpack the building in the reverse order in the spring.

Just a reminder that we do offer summer storage. You can take advantage of our summer storage rate of \$200 for the summer (or \$2 per day for shorter periods) and keep your RV under roof year around.

Some items to do and check before storing:

- Winterize your RV.
- Close the valves on propane gas tanks or remove the tanks.
- Remove any food, beverages & liquids from refrigerator and cabinets, etc.
- Vacuum carpets.
- Prop your refrigerator door open.
- It is best to remove your battery and store in a warm place. At least plan to disconnect it, because some RVs have electronics that are not turned off by any switches and if your battery becomes discharged, it will probably need to be replaced in the spring. For motorhomes, adding a disconnect at the battery is recommended; this is a very simple addition and will guarantee there is no stray current to drain battery.
- Check your tire pressure for proper inflation.
- Please take a look through your RV to make sure you have removed any items you may need before spring. Appliances, medications, papers, etc. (You will **NOT** have access to your RV for the storage period.)

Please call before bringing your RV, so we are sure to be here.
